WHAT WE DO & WHO WE ARE

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Weber-Davis served a total of **882 registered members**, provided **10,325 healthy snacks**, and enrolled **295 youth** in our Create @ The Club program in 2020.

Responding to COVID: During the pandemic, we connected more than **100 youth** to supportive virtual programs, provided **critical meals** to local families, offered **two summer camps** and opened our new Ogden Teen Drop-in Center.

94% of our youth state, a staff member pays attention to what is going on in their lives.

74% of our teens volunteer in their school, neighborhood, or community regularly.

92% of our youth problem solve when something important in their lives goes wrong.

86% of our youth and teens are physically active for at least 60 minutes, two or more days per week.

47% of our frontline staff are minority.

87% of our youth report that there is an adult on staff who believes they will be successful.

85% of our youth and teens expect to complete post-secondary education.
